- * The leaf colours red, yellow & brown are present in the leaves all year long & only become exposed when the green chlorophyll disappears in the autumn.
- * Brown colours come from a waste product called tannin, orange colours comes from carotene ('kar-uh-teen) & the yellows from xanthophyll ('zan-thuh-fil)
