Dear Parent/Carer,

The staff at Green Lane Primary Academy have recently received training in giving emergency first aid in the event of a severe allergic reaction following exposure to peanuts and other allergens. We currently have three members of the academy community who are vulnerable to such a severe allergic reaction, known as anaphylaxis. Sometimes, sufferers only need to be in the same room as another person eating nuts, to react.

We have been reassured by the school nurse that it is extremely unlikely that we will have to deal with such an emergency situation however, we are keen to minimise any risks. It is for this reason, that as from Monday 21st November, all products containing nuts should not be brought into the academy. This also includes packed lunches on school trips and residential. Our catering supervisor has received training and ensures that all academy meals comply with medical advice.

Thank you for your support in helping us to keep GLPA a healthy and safe environment.
